Finding Joy In Our Discouragements

1. Elizabeth and Mary: Mother's Joy

Note: Joy isn't separate from paid and discouragement—<u>But rather</u>—much of <u>joy</u> is born out of <u>long</u> <u>discouragement</u> and <u>grief</u>.

Luke 1:5-7

1) Elizabeth's Incredible Birth

Luke 1:11-13

Luke 1:18-20

Problem: Zechariah has trouble believing and so he won't be able to speak until his son is born. Luke 1:25

Luke 1:24

Odd: Elizabeth hides herself for 5 months: A lifetime of hopes, grief, loss...??

Question: How are you handling your heartache's and discouragements?

2) Mary's Impossible Birth

<u>Luke 1:26-28</u> <u>Matthew 1:20, 21</u> <u>Luke 1:29, 30</u> <u>Notice</u>: "Don't be afraid!" "Peace be with you." "Favored one." "The Lord is with you." <u>Judges 6:12</u> (To Gideon) *"The Lord is with you."* <u>The Point</u>: God is calling Mary and Joseph to an <u>overwhelming experience</u>—but <u>He Himself</u> is with <u>them</u> and He will <u>empower them fully</u> thru it <u>all</u>! <u>Luke 1:34-39</u>
