Revelation 4:11

- * It is <u>not</u> great men who change the world, but <u>weak</u> men in the <u>Hands</u> of a <u>Great God</u>." ~Brother Yun
- * "Trust in Jesus starts by being in a place that gives us a Glimpse of His Glory."
- * "The Glory of God is a living man; and the life of man consists in beholding God." ~Irenaeus

"Glory" (GK: doxa) - brilliance, majesty, grandeur, radiance, magnificence

1. In Death: Seeing The Glory

"Jesus' <u>suffering</u> led to <u>glory</u>. And if you <u>know</u> that <u>glory</u> is coming, you can <u>handle suffering</u> too." ~Keller

Huge Question: "Are those closest to me being pulled by God's Glory in me to know Christ?"

* "God is glorified not only by His Glory being seen and noticed but also by us rejoicing in it." ~Edwards

2. The Glory on Stephen's Face

Acts 6:8, 12, 13, 15

Acts 7:54-56, 59, 60

⇒ Stephen, like Peter and John, was so <u>full</u> of <u>God's Glory</u> that he <u>could not help but speak out!</u> <u>John 7:37-39</u>

Revelation 19:1, 7-9

⇒ Those who killed Stephen <u>saw</u> the <u>Glory of God</u> on Stephen's battered face; the <u>Glory of God</u> revealing God's Great presence and power, <u>outlived Stephen's life</u>.

FOUR TRUTHS:

- 1) A Paradox: Our darkest moments carry with them the Weight of Glory.
- 2) <u>God makes Himself Known</u> not <u>despite</u> the wreckage of our lives but <u>thru</u> the <u>wreckage</u> itself.
- 2 Timothy 4:16, 17
- 3) <u>There Is No Greater Strength</u>: Than to <u>forgive</u> your enemies in your <u>weakest</u> moment. (Jesus, Stephen, Paul)
- 4) <u>The Future Glory of God</u>: Gives you the <u>strength</u> to <u>overcome</u> when you <u>cannot see</u> the Glory now.
