Then you will <u>overflow with confident hope</u> thru the <u>power of</u> the <u>Holy</u> Spirit." Micah 1:3, 8 "Look! The Lord is coming from His dwelling place; He comes down and treads the high places of the earth... Because of this I will weep and wail... I will howl like a jackal, and moan like an owl..." * The prophet Micah tells us of God's judgment against the sins of Judah, but also in spires by speaking of the coming Messiah and His Kingdom of peace. **Three Truths:** 1.
