1. Adjusting Our Thinking

John 4:34-36

## **Some Obvious Truths:**

- 1) "Before there can be any harvest, there always has to be a season of gardening."
- 2) People Need a period of time: thinking about the gospel, wondering if its true: "God, are You real?"
- 3) When we learn to garden better: eventually the harvest will be better too!
- 4) Experiencing God Principle: "You must make <u>major adjustments</u> in your life <u>to join God</u> in <u>what He is doing."</u>
- 1 Timothy 6:20, 21
- 1 Timothy 4:1, 2, 7, 10, 11
- 2 Timothy 1:8, 13, 14

## 2. Gardening Tools

Colossians 4:5, 6

## **Paul Gives Three Elements:**

- 1) Be Smart: Move slowly; Be a state, not blunt; prayful not sloppy
- 2) Be Kind: Show caring sweetness, probe gently, stay calm and patient.

Note: If anyone gets mad—you lose!

3) <u>Be Tactical</u>: Have <u>A Game Plan</u>—Adjust to the individual, tailor your words to his special situation, every person is unique

Remember: We're doing gardening -get them thinking, no "Hail Mary Passes" needed

Matthew 10:39 "If you <u>cling</u> to your life, you will <u>lose</u> it; <u>but</u> if you <u>give up your life</u> for Me, <u>you will find</u> it."

## 3. Three Skills To Develop

1) Knowledge: The message of God's Kingdom

Matthew 10:16

1 Corinthians 1:17-19

Acts 26:22-25

2) Wisdom: Makes our message clear and persuasive

Two Key Areas: Offensive Apologetics: A Positive Case For Christianity: Gives evidence for God's

<u>existence</u>, Christs <u>Resurrection</u>, or <u>Bible's Inspiration</u>

Romans 1:15-23

**Defensive Apologetics:** Answers challenges meant to undermine or disprove Christianity

2 Timothy 2:15-18

3) Christ Like Character

1 Corinthians 12:31-13:3

<u>The Big, HUGE NEED</u>: If we do not <u>embody the love of Christ</u>, we will by our own <u>failure</u> and <u>flavor of our flesh</u> <u>turn people off to Jesus Christ</u>.
