Today's Message: Responding to Same Sex Attraction

Three Truths:

1) It's OK to give "Sunday School" answers to <u>difficult issues</u> when children are young—<u>But</u> if we do so when <u>they get older-young people leave</u> and often <u>don't come back</u>.

Ephesians 6:12 2 Corinthians 10:4, 5

Years Ago: "Just Say No" to homosexuality wasn't compelling and is definitely not now.

2) If we are to <u>persevere</u> in the <u>life of discipleship</u> and <u>persuade</u> any to join us, it must <u>not</u> be by a set of rules but <u>rather</u> a <u>dynamic relationship</u> with <u>the living</u> God.

John 10:10"I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." And Jesus always speaks truth.3) When life is lived with this God at the center, the Christian life is not only possible, it is wonderful.Leviticus 18:22Romans 1:26, 271 Corinthians 6:9, 10

A Warning: <u>Three Big Weapons</u>

- 1) <u>Emotions</u>: pulling on heart strings, distressing stories, we need to <u>resist</u> the temptation to let <u>painful</u> <u>stories trump revealed truth</u>.
- 2) **Polarization:** pushing people to <u>extremes</u> to <u>keep</u> people from <u>seeing</u> the <u>power Christ alone gives</u>.
- 3) <u>Sowing Doubt</u>: Breaking basic rules of Bible interpretation (<u>leaving out full context</u>), setting out <u>Scripture against Scripture</u>.

Example: Galatians 3:27, 28

<u>GRINDING SMALL</u>: <u>Three Key Missteps</u>: "<u>Direction</u>, not intention <u>determining</u> your <u>destination</u>." <u>Misstep 1</u>: "Your identity is your sexuality."

Labels Matter: Get This: The thing that matters most is not your sexuality <u>But</u>, your status <u>in</u> <u>Christ</u>, as a <u>child of God</u>.

Truth: Our identity is defined by Gods Word, not by the world around us.

Misstep 2: "If you're born gay, it can't be wrong to be gay."

To Some: it's their DNA—it's natural—so can't be wrong to express it; "it's my human right to be myself."

Psalm 51:5, 7-9

<u>SADLY</u>: Preachers and teachers today tend to <u>keep quiet</u> about "<u>original sin</u>", it sounds unfair, people don't like it, it's not popular.

<u>Truth</u>: We must communicate well that <u>natural instinct</u> to do something <u>doesn't mean its right</u>. **Misstep 3:** "If it makes you happy, it must be right"

<u>Reality</u>: Our Great Need—the ultimate authority—God Himself, His Word, being my authority obeying, and following Him. <u>Hebrews 12:2</u>

Key: Allowing temporary unhappiness; exchanging it for the <u>Genuine Things</u>, that <u>we can experience</u> even now.
