<u>1 Thessalonians 5:23</u> "May your whole <u>spirit</u>, <u>soul</u>, and <u>body</u> be <u>preserved blameless</u>."

Our Septic Thoughts—can imprison us in a hellish well of toxic waste.

2. We \_\_\_\_\_ A King

Psalm 2:6 "As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill."

## **Three Questions:**

- 1) <u>Who are we?</u> <u>Romans 3:10-12</u> "As it is written: '<u>None is righteous</u>, no, not one; no one understands; no one seeks God. <u>All have turned aside...</u> <u>no one does good</u>..."
- 2) <u>Who is God?</u> He is totally over all <u>in authority</u>, in <u>control</u>, and <u>very present</u> ("God with us"), who is <u>Holy</u> and yet wants to <u>be involved</u> in our lives.
- 3) Who is this anointed One? Psalm 2:7, 8 "I will tell you the decree: The Lord said to Me, 'You are My

Son, today I have begotten You. Ask for Me, and I will give you the nations for your heritage..."

Hebrews 1:5

John 5:21-23

<u>Revelation 11:15</u> "Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, 'The Kingdom of the world <u>has become</u> the <u>Kingdom of our Lord</u> and of <u>His Christ</u>, and <u>He shall</u> <u>reign forever and ever</u>."

3. We \_\_\_\_\_ The King

Psalm 2:1-3, 10-12

Psalm 2:3 "Let us break their chains and throw off their shackles."

Toxic Thinking—we think that following God causes bondage—when He is the Bondage Breaker!

<u>Psalm 2:11, 12</u> "Serve the Lord with fear and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and you perish in the way, for His wrath is quickly kindled. Blessed are all who take refuge in Him."

**Reality:** God wants us in <u>relationship to Him</u>, He wants us to <u>recognize our proper place before Him</u>, but to <u>rejoice in Him</u> and be <u>loving in our relationship</u>.
