1. Rage Rash—Neutralizing The of Anger
"Anger is an acid that can <u>do more harm</u> to the vessel in which it is than to anything on which it is <u>poured</u> ." ~Mark Twain
Ephesians 4:26, 27 "In your anger do not sin: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry and do not give the devil a foothold."
Psalms 4:4 "In your anger do not sin."
"Foothold" - Greek—"topos" - opportunity or location, an territory
Two Types of Anger:
1) <u>Mark 3:1-6</u>
Mark 3:5 "He looked around at them in anger deeply distressed at their stubborn hearts"
⇒ Jesus didn't allow His anger to cause Him to sin—He it to do good—healing the man!
John 11:38 "Jesus was <u>still angry</u> as He arrived at the tomb…"
⇒ Jesus is angry at <u>sin's huge hurt</u> , at the <u>power</u> and <u>destruction</u> of the <u>enemy</u> : <u>death</u> , so He actually <u>groans</u> like a horse snorting.
Romans 12:9 "Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good."
2) <u>Anger</u> — <u>Genesis 4:6, 7</u> "Why are you angry? Why is your face down cast?… <u>Sin is crouching</u> at <u>your door</u> ; it <u>desires to have you</u> , but <u>you must rule over it</u> ."
"" - have a short fuse, a hot temper
Proverbs 14:17 "A quick-tempered man does foolish things."
<u>Proverbs 29:11</u> "Fools give <u>full vent</u> to their rage."
"" - bottle up their anger, slow-burning coals
Psalms 32:3 "When I kept silent, my bones wasted away thru my groaning all day long."
"Love is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs." (Stewers keep long records)
Truth: "Spewers" and "Stewers", both, are likely in the <u>sewer</u> unless <u>control</u> is <u>learned</u> .
<u>James 1:19-20</u>
Galatians 5:22-23 " the <u>fruit</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> <u>self-control</u> "
2. Scare Pollution—Unlocking the Chokehold of Fear
A) Four Main Types:

1) Fear of Loss—a major thief—stealing your joy and peace

Ex: losing a spouse, a child, financial loss, losing control

Philippians 4:6-9

2) Fear of Failure—often afraid that I just don't have what it takes (husband, dad, job)

Truth: BIG God... BIG Vision... BIG Risks → BIG GOD

Luke 1:37

3) Fear of Rejection—many are controlled by a people pleasing mind

Exodus 20:3 "You shall have no other gods before Me."

- 4) **Fear of Unknown**—the "What If's" worrying about things you cannot control
- B) Faith In The Wrong Things: Imagination Running Wild— "What Ifs" vs. "God Is"
- 1) What you fear <u>reveals</u> what you <u>value</u> the most: <u>examine your fears</u>: <u>reveals</u> your <u>priorities</u>
- 2) What you fear reveals where you trust God the least

Psalms 56:1-4
