<u>Loving arguments</u> are a virtue—they advance <u>clear thinking</u>, helping us to <u>understand the</u> truth.

3. In A Darkened World We Are to Argue Properly/Lovingly

John 6:44 Romans 8:14-16

Two Reminders:

- 1) <u>You can't</u> "<u>love</u> someone into the Kingdom", <u>you can't argue</u> someone into the Kingdom; without the Holy Spirit working—nothing works.
- 2) With The Spirits Work: Love persuades, arguments convince

Romans 3:9-20

- "There can't just be one way to God"
- "I can't believe in a God who sends people to hell"
- "Science had disproved the supernatural"

Today's Focus: "To Put A Stone In Someone's Shoe"

<u>The Goal</u>: "Since I know I am a part of the process, I want to give him/her something worth thinking about."

Why "Grind Small?"

- 1) **The Simple Gospel**: is no longer simple—the world is in <u>dramatic change</u>
- 2) <u>Objections Abound</u>: hostility to Christianity dominates our culture: Harris/Dawkins: The Rage Against God
- 3) Most Christians: Will "garden" more than "harvest"

<u>John 4:27-38 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, 58</u> <u>1 Corinthians 16:9</u>

Sad Fact: Most people aren't ready for a "cross conversation" - they have "no furniture"

Paul saw obstacles—"<u>closed doors</u>" as <u>opportunities</u> to <u>keep asking</u> and <u>keep pressing</u>, <u>not</u> signals

4. Small Steps To Take

- ♦ Pray for wisdom John 15:5, 7, 8
- ◆ <u>Ask Yourself</u>: What is <u>one thing</u> I can Say? What is <u>one question</u> I can ask? <u>What is one single</u> <u>idea</u> I can offer that will <u>get them thinking</u>?
- ◆ **Refusing to Quit**—Refusing to get Impatient
- ♦ Be a good gardener—then trust God to bring the harvest in His time!
