Romans 8:17 Three Truths:

1) Our sharing in suffering now is a condition of our future glorification.

- 2) Our <u>BRIGHTNESS</u> increases as <u>we go thru pain</u> and <u>sorrow</u> as <u>Christ's glory</u> shine's <u>thru His</u> cross. Daniel 12:2, 3
- 3) "Spirit fullness happens when you are overwhelmed with Christs love and this love overflows to others."

<u>2 Corinthians 2:14</u> <u>2 Corinthians 4:4, 6, 7</u> <u>2 Corinthians 4:15-18</u>

<u>Salvation Means</u>: that the <u>Spirit of God</u> has brought me into <u>Intimate Contact</u> with the true person of <u>Christ Himself</u>... so I am caught up into <u>total surrender</u> to <u>Christ</u>—I become <u>THRILLED</u> with something Infinitely GREATER than myself."

1. What's Inside Comes Outside

Mark 7:20-24

Question: "Why do we all feel guilty?" Answer: "Because we are all guilty."

Question: "What does it mean to be human?" Answer: Bill Nye: "We are just a speck, on a speck, or biting a speck, among other specs"

<u>Answer: Carl Sagan</u>: "We find ourselves in a <u>bottomless free fall</u>... lost in a <u>great darkness</u>, and there's no one to send out a search party."

Ecclesiastes 3:11 "God has set eternity in our hearts."

Psalm 8:5 "You (God) have crowned them with glory and honor."

Reality: At the very core of our beings is a mark—the imprint of God Himself.

Genesis 1:27 "God created man in His own image."

<u>Intimacy With God</u>: <u>Allowing myself to be fully Known</u>, <u>fully loved</u>, <u>fully accepted</u>, letting down <u>my guard completely</u>." <u>God longs</u> to have this kind of love <u>with me</u>.
