2. Real _____ Ahead If Childs Heart Neglected — Luke 6:43-45

Danger Ahead: If you only regulate and ______ behavior, when they leave home—they may not have a changed heart!

Three Foolish Strategies:

1) <u>Threats</u>—attempting to <u>change</u> without dealing with the heart—only works ______.

2) <u>Manipulation or Negotiation</u>—no change, no love, self rules still (reinforced by parent).

3) <u>Guilt</u>—<u>Shame Them</u>—attempt to change child without dealing with the heart properly.
